



A LEVEL AND GCSE RESULTS 2019

Harrogate Ladies' College achieves outstanding academic results. Studying with us adds an average of one grade to estimated exam results in every subject – this progress, or Value Added score places us within the top 5% of schools in the UK.

GCSE Results

- > **55%** of all grades were 9-7 (A*-A)
- > **89%** of all grades were 9-4 (A*-C)
- > **56%** of all girls were awarded 5 or more 9-7 grades (A*-A)
- > **80%** or more 9-7 grades in 8 subjects including Biology, Physics & Further Maths

A level Results

- > **61%** of all grades were A*-B
- > **81%** of all grades were A*-C
- > **100%** of all Further Maths grades at A*-A

University Destinations

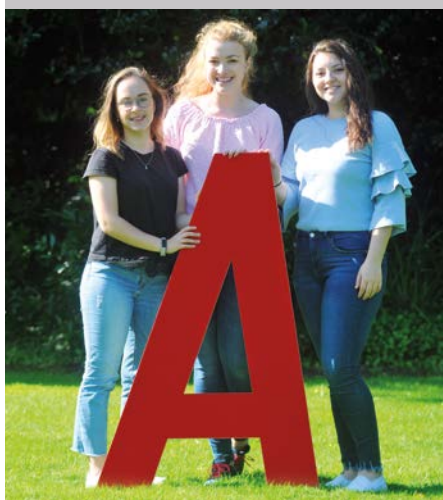
At Harrogate Ladies' College we have an excellent track record of securing places at some of the UK's top Universities. The majority of our girls secure their first choice of university, a high percentage of which are Russell Group institutions.

We always encourage our pupils to be themselves and to choose the path, and therefore the course, that is right for them. The diversity of the subjects our girls go on to study is a real reflection of this and our overall ethos.

In 2019 over 80% received offers from Russell Group universities and 79% secured their preferred choice of university.
