

HARROGATE LADIES' COLLEGE. ADMISSIONS INFORMATION FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS 2021/22.

EACH YEAR WE HAVE A NUMBER OF PLACES AVAILABLE FOR INTERNATIONAL PUPILS TO JOIN US IN COLLEGE FROM THE AGES OF 11 TO 18 YEARS (YEAR 7 TO YEAR 12).

International students can apply to join us in any year group (directly or via an agent).

All international applicants are asked to:

- > Complete English and Maths entrance exam papers
- > Have an interview (or Skype) with our Principal, Mrs Sylvia Brett
- > Provide a copy of their most recent school report
- > Provide a copy of their passport

We like to ask that international students have an appropriate level of English for the year group they are applying to join so that they can understand the classes they attend, but above all we are looking for girls who have a real passion for joining our school and integrating with our school community.

Ethos and Aims

We aim to develop a deep passion for learning and a love of life in all of our pupils. This ethos underpins everything we do and is at the heart of our school community.

We are a Christian foundation and our pupils are challenged to be the best that they can be, both inside and outside the classroom.

Guardians

We ask that all non-EU students have a guardian living in the UK. We also strongly recommend that EU students have a UK based guardian.

International Scholarships

We have an International Scholarship Programme which offers a small number of scholarships each year to international students with an exceptional talent in a particular area including: Academic, Art, Textiles, Music, and Sport. Please contact our Admissions Team for more information.

Fees for 2021/22

We aim to make our fees as inclusive as possible to help families to plan for their daughter's education. Our termly Boarding Fees include:

- > Tuition
- Accommodation (during term time)
- All meals including breakfast, lunch, supper plus mid-morning and afternoon snacks
- > Full laundry service
- > Supervised after school homework sessions
- > Most text books
- > Medical provision from the College Health Centre
- > Extensive extra-curricular programme

Our boarding fees for the academic year beginning September 2021 are as follows:

EU pupils (entry into all Years)

£11,000 per term

Non-EU pupils (entry into Year 7-11)

£11,325 per term

Non-EU pupils (entry into Year 12-13)*

£13,785 per term

*Pupils who join us before Year 12 and continue into the Sixth Form will continue to pay Year7-11 fees.

Non-EU fees are applicable to all families who are not domiciled in the EU.

Fees are invoiced termly and are payable before the start of each term.

Fee Discounts

A discount of 5% is available for any girl who has a younger sibling in College. Daughters and grand-daughters of former pupils also receive a 10% fee reduction.

Registration Fee and Deposit

There is a non-refundable Registration Fee of £75 for all applications. Once you receive an offer from College, you'll also be asked to pay a deposit in order to secure your place.

English as an Additional Language (EAL) and IELTS

To ensure that our international students receive the English language support that they need, we assess each student (normally before they arrive) and identify the number of additional lessons required each week. As the level of support differs for each pupil these costs are not included in our standard fees, and are charged as follows:

Individual lesson (35 mins): £34 per lesson

Group lessons 2-5 pupils (70 mins): £34 per lesson

Group lessons 6-10 pupils (70 mins): £24 per lesson

Modern Language Tuition

Individual lesson (35 mins): £20 per lesson

Music Lessons

Pre-arranged instrument and singing lessons are available on a weekly basis. Individual lessons lasting 35 minutes cost £27 per lesson.

For beginners in string, woodwind or brass, a school instrument is available for hire for the first year at a cost of £50 per term.
